Four organisations in three historic buildings in Bellerive are opening their doors to the public on Wednesday **May 1**, to offer a unique historical experience.

- The Hobart branch of the **Tasmanian Family History Society** - you can examine their resources and find out how they can assist in discovering your family history.

- **Sound Preservation Association of Tasmania** - a collection of sounds from the past and the equipment on which those sounds can be reproduced. You can listen to recordings of Tasmanian voices, Tasmanian compositions and Tasmanian events and see a display of audio equipment and memorabilia.

- **Bellerive Historical Society** - an opportunity to learn about the history of the Bellerive area and arm yourself with a map of the historic houses in the area.

- **Ferryman's House** - a private museum in a turn-of-the-century building on the Esplanade, full to the gunwales with Bellerive memorabilia.
